## **High Swartz Attorney to Speak at 2011 Municipal Law Colloquium**

**May 19, 2011, Norristown, PA** — Alan W. Flenner, municipal, land use and environmental law attorney with High Swartz LLP in Norristown, will be a featured speaker at the Pennsylvania Bar Institute's Municipal Law Colloquium, to be held June 3 - 4 at the Lancaster County Convention Center in Lancaster. The seminar will explore updates in municipal law that are relevant to both new and experienced municipal solicitors.
